EXPECTATIONS FOR YDT STUDENTS

Ellel Ministries is founded on Christian beliefs and values and as such regards seriously God's call for His people to live lives of holiness and obedience.

Students enrolled in the Year of Discipleship and Training are developing skills to be applied in ministry and are seen to be representatives of both Christ and Ellel Ministries. They should, therefore, strive to reflect Biblical values and represent Christ in their lifestyle and relationships as outlined in the Scriptures (for example, 1 Timothy 3 and Ephesians 4:17 - 5:21). This covers areas such as character (self-control, addictions, language) and sexual purity (sexual abstinence except within a committed, legally recognised marriage).





In addition to the above policies, students should at all times endeavour to uphold the ethos of Ellel Ministries which are based on mainstream Christian beliefs and values, as outlined in the YDT Handbook which can be found on our website (http://ellel.org/au/get-involved/year-of-discipleship-and-training). CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT AND PRIVACY

1. Enrolment and course fees

- 1.1 Fees must be paid in Australian dollars directly to Ellel Ministries either by credit card, bank cheque or bank transfer. Ellel Ministries will not be responsible for any monies paid to agents.
- 1.2 Ellel Ministries reserves the right to vary fees at the beginning of each calendar year.
- 1.3 Cost of textbooks or other course specific equipment (where relevant) are detailed in the Course Outline/s and can be purchased from the Ellel Bookshop upon arrival.

2. Course duration

- 2.1 A course commences on the first day of 'Orientation'.
- 2.2 Students will be advised of the course duration prior to enrolment. It is expected that students will remain for the entirety of the year.

3. Attendance

3.1 All students must attend at least 75% of classes (or the face-to-face component) in each subject / course that requires in class attendance/participation/assessment.

4 Termination

4.1 Ellel Ministries has the right to expel a student for serious breach of discipline. Fees will not be refunded.

5 Accommodation and living expenses

- 5.1 Live-in food and accommodation fees are to be paid upon arrival.
- 5.2 Room agreements will also be signed upon arrival.
- 5.3 Students will be given notice well in advance of any upcoming expenses for YDT activities or necessary purchase of resources. It is the responsibility of the student to make provision for these expenses.

6. Cancellation and refund

- 6.1 The only fees which will be refunded are as per the Refunds Policy & Procedure.
- 6.2 All applicants are required to read the Refunds Policy & Procedure published in the Student Handbook before signing the above 'Declaration'.
