500... and still counting!

Ellel Grange has just celebrated its 500th Healing Retreat since the work began there in 1986. And having taught the very first Healing Retreat, what a privilege it was to teach the first session of the 500th, and to think back over the years at the extraordinary things that God has done in the lives of so many of the 12,000 people who have come through the doors of Ellel Grange, looking to God for answers to their problems on their retreat.

One of the women who came on that very first retreat, anorexic, desperate and suicidal is, today, one of the Ellel Grange ministry team. A man who came, smoking 60 cigarettes a day and bereft of any hope of escape from the feelings that engulfed him, is now leading the healing team in a US Church! God dramatically healed them both.

So far there have been over 3,000 Healing Retreats when you add up all those which have taken place at all our other centres. The fruit for the Kingdom of God is beyond calculation as so many have returned home rejoicing with a story to tell. Many of the people who come on

our training courses are there because of the testimony of their friends who have been on a retreat.

Such has been the fruit from those early beginnings that there are now over 30 Centres around the world. In September Ellel Grange will be hosting our International Leaders Conference, when eighty international leaders will squeeze themselves into the building where it all started and spend a week together preparing themselves in the Lord for the next season of the ministry.

We certainly live in very challenging and testing times – the keys that God has given for healing and restoration are increasingly needed in the Body of Christ. Jesus is still seeking after the ones who are hurting and when He finds and heals them, what a wonderful message is conveyed to the 99! (Luke 15:3-6).

We praise God with great thanksgiving in our hearts for the journey so far, for every single person who has been on a Healing Retreat and for all the things that God has laid before us for the years and the Retreats yet to come.

Ellel Responds to the Crisis in Ukraine

Ellel Russian Language is a part of our work that is often fraught with challenges and complications, covering a vast area with geo-political issues that make life very interesting indeed! The situation in Ukraine is a cause for deep concern that was highlighted during a recent school attended by both Ukrainians and Russians.

In this article, Roger Pook, Regional Director, Central and Eastern Europe opens up the situation from a wider perspective that is based on his experience of working in this region for over twenty years.

A WORK OF RESTORATION

They will rebuild the ancient ruins. They will restore the places destroyed long ago. They will renew the ruined cities, the places destroyed generations ago. ISAIAH 61:4

For three generations, communism brought ruin and destruction across Central and Eastern Europe. In the name of 'progress' the environment was scarred by thoughtless exploitation, beauty from the past was destroyed, and there was brutal exploitation of people and oppression of Christians. New generations arose who had no spiritual foundations to their lives.

Foreigners will come forward and become shepherds for your flocks, and children of foreigners will work your fields and vineyards. ISAIAH 61:5

In 1992, Ellel Ministries started its first overseas work when Otto and Sharon Bixler arrived in Hungary to set up the centre that was known as *Ellel East*. In 2001 the Hungarian Ministry Centre was finally completed at Ūr Rétje – 'The Lord's Meadow'. Still more "foreigners came forward" to "work in the fields". The work spread to many other nations, with the base in Hungary as the hub.

You will be called the priests of the LORD. You will be called the servants of our God. You will consume the wealth of the nations. You will boast in their splendour. ISAIAH 61:6

There are now four 'centres' in the Central and Eastern Europe region of Ellel Ministries – Ellel Hungary; Ellel Romania; Ellel Russian Language, which covers all nations where Russian is either the first language or widely spoken; and the Ellel CEE Development Centre, which works in countries of the region which do not yet have an established Ellel team. Our aim is to work with and through local churches, and equip the nationals to be what we foreigners can never be – "the priests of the LORD" for their nation.

You will receive a double measure of wealth instead of your shame. You will sing about your wealth instead of being disgraced. That is why you will have a double measure of wealth in your land. You will have everlasting joy. ISAIAH 61:7

The first Eastern European country to have a local Ellel team was Ukraine. (Hungary is part of Central Europe.) There was a series of conferences starting in 1994, and the first Ministry School started near Kiev in 1998 with 51 students. Ukrainians were trained to minister in their churches, and some were called to join the Ministry as associate prayer ministers and later as full team members. Shorter schools, church visits and the Video School took place across Ukraine and then in other Russian-speaking countries, as far as Vladivostok in the Russian Far East. Many thousands of people have been blessed, healed and equipped.

Our aim is to work with and through local churches, and equip the nationals to be "the priests of the LORD" for their nation.

THE ELLEL TEAM IN UKRAINE & RUSSIA

There are six Ellel Team members in Ukraine and three in Russia, all living within 200 miles / 300 kilometres of the current war zone. Life is not easy for them, but they continue to follow their programme of teaching and ministry. Most of them are struggling to deal with fears and frustration. In this time of testing, it is difficult for them to find inner peace. One Russian team member "weeps for Ukraine" and can no longer bear to watch the Russian news broadcasts.

It is even worse for our Associate Ministry Team in Ukraine, some of whom live in the actual war zone. One prayer minister in Slaviansk saw her church building seized by terrorists and used as a sniper base. Thankfully, Slaviansk has since been liberated.

It is also emotionally difficult for us as Regional Directors. For twenty years we have taught and ministered all across Ukraine and Russia. We love the people, and we love the places. It is hard to see the suffering and deception.

Divine Rights?

On a continuing quest for the truth of human rights, by David Cross.



As I have previously mentioned, the *Age of Enlightenment* or the *Age of Reason* both refer to a historical period, and an associated intellectual movement, in eighteenth century Europe, the purpose of which was to reform society by academic endeavor rather than blind acceptance of the religious and governmental orthodoxy of the past. Over centuries, church and state leaders had repeatedly demonstrated corrupt, inept and superstitious practices, often supported by distorted biblical arguments.

Thomas Paine, in his work *The Rights of Man*, in 1791, wrote, "Individuals themselves, each in his own personal and sovereign right, entered into a contract with each other to produce a government, and this is the only mode in which governments have a right to arise, and the only principle on which they have a right to exist." This social contract is surely a very reasonable human viewpoint of how governments should receive their authority to rule, but it is not the whole truth of Scripture.

Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God. ROMANS 13:1. NAS.

The Enlightenment thinkers were understandably looking for reformed structures of government in society but, by ignoring God as the true source of all authority (however defiled it might have become through man's sin), they set in place powerful foundations for a new humanism, declaring that man himself was to be the source of all authority and wisdom. Thomas Paine and other philosophers of the period particularly challenged the concept of the *Divine Right of Kings*, an apparently biblically-based assertion that a monarch should be subject to no earthly correction, resulting in many rulers justifying their despotism from scripture (1 Peter 2:13). In fact, God warned His people that kings would inevitably become power hungry.

"So then, listen to them (the people), but give them strict warnings and explain how their kings will treat them." 1 SAMUEL 8:9. GNB.

God is the Creator of everything that exists, so every concept and structure of authority originate from Him, even though these get badly distorted by man's sin. People need to be led, otherwise they face the destructive instability of mob rule. The problem is that all rulers, even if anointed to lead, are also likely to sin. The rightful authority of a king is not a license for him to exercise undisputed tyranny. King James I of England took the Bible seriously, instigating the familiar translation we still use today. He believed, like many others, that his right to rule had been conferred on him by God at his coronation anointing. However James further believed that the Bible endorsed his view that the king had *absolute* authority, not subject to human challenge.

But the Bible does *not* say that the conferring of a right to rule means that a king or leader (whether secular or spiritual) is somehow imbued with absolute truth or infallibility. No human being should ever be beyond the Godly correction of others. The Bible instructs us to respect the God-founded structures and institutions of authority but not to blindly condone the sinful practices of those who participate in those institutions. King James, like so many rulers down through history, was frequently more self-centred than God-centered, and he was not a perfect conduit of divine wisdom. However, rather than abandon the Godly order of governmental authority, our best response to wayward rulers is to first intercede for them that they would be convicted of what is contrary to God's commands.

First of all, then, I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men, for kings and all who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity. 1 TIMOTHY 2:1,2. NAS.

But what if the ruler or king continues in his sinful ways? Next time, we will see how the nobles of England dealt with King John in the year 1215, by means of the famous Magna Carta. Was this an early birth-place for the philosophy of man's natural rights?



A Vision of Beauty

Ellel Hungary

In 2009 Ellel Hungary addressed a need of their nation that God had put on their heart. This was to put on an event solely for women to show them the depth of their beauty and how to portray that beauty to others. They arranged a one-day conference called, 'Discovering your Beauty' and the response was amazing... many applications had to be rejected as the limit of 80 women was very quickly reached.

In response, they ran another event two months later, renting a larger facility to allow for as many women to come as possible... 230 attended! Clearly there was a need that went very deep and the team soon realised that this desperate need was rooted in the Communist era of the Hungarian nation. During this period, the women had been beaten down and suppressed. There was very little color and style in their dress, no make-up on them, no-one to show them how to be beautiful, no-one to feed their human spirit in the whole area of beauty. During that time everything that was labeled 'Beauty' was either 'forbidden western culture', 'promiscuous' or 'unnecessary'. Stores in those days carried black, grey or blue items for ladies. Some of these women have never been to the hair-dressers and a lot of them have never even used make-up!

This suppression of their outward presentation of beauty was not the only thing affected. The suppression was deep in the hearts of these women; all believing that there was nothing beautiful, valuable, or creative about them, and that being beautiful was almost akin to being sinful. Their inner-beauty was quashed as much as their outer beauty; and both needed addressing.

We knew that, for most of them, it is not enough to say, "You are beautiful and it is not a sinful thing to put some make-up on to enhance your beauty." Or, "Some color would look great on you, and would really bring out your personality". We realised that someone actually had to show them how to do it; and the vision was born for a practical, hands-on course.

The underlying theme of the courses is to make every participant feel like royalty, like they are truly the daughters of the Most High King. The ladies learn about breaking free from the past, cultivating beauty on the inside, freedom from guilt and shame, purity and Godly identity as well as practical seminars led by professional volunteers, such as hair-styling, make-up training, 'Color me beautiful' color tips, and a manicure for every guest.

This visibly feeds their spirit, it is amazing to watch. So far Ellel Hungary has run two 3-day 'Discover Your Beauty' courses and the testimonies were, and are still amazing! This year we are planning two more of these courses - one at our centre, and another one at a country-side church where they have invited us to put on this event for their women.

Testimonies:

"Taking part in the women's course was one of my hardest decisions to make ever since I have been attending Christian conferences. I was just stumbling between the need for something like this and the feelings that it's unnecessary, waste of time, vanity. Now I don't know how to express the huge profit I gained there. Your healing words about the truths of beauty deeply touched me. Deeper than I could have ever expected! I am able now, for the first time in my life, to put on make-up without feeling a deep sense of guilt and shame. Thanks to the color-tips, I am able to choose suitable clothes for myself and for my family for the first time. And a surprising change - colors have even started to appear in our home on the walls, guests have commented that it feels so much more welcoming!"

"One of the highlights of the course for me was when the male members of the team came up in front of us and apologized to us for any sins or negative actions or words that have ever been committed against us by men in our lives. It greatly enabled me to forgive the men in my life."

"For the first time in my life I saw a glimpse of what true freedom in a woman's life looks like. I can't thank you enough for the powerful testimony of that identity that you lived in front of us with your team."

"The Lord has been telling me for a while that He thinks I am beautiful and I am His princess, but I did not want to accept it. I still struggle a bit with this notion, but thanks to the teachings and the practical workshops, I am much farther along the way now than before. I also came to understand that it is not sinful to enhance my beauty on the outside. Thank you for that!"



The Issue of 'Beauty'

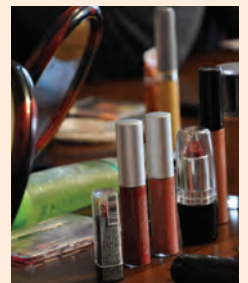

Discipling Young People

Young People's Team (YPT)

Ever since the very early days of the work, our UK centres have depended on the hard work and dedication of young people who give up a year of their lives to serve God. Young people aged 18-25 come from all over the world and many say it is a life-changing experience.

These young people fulfil the majority of the tasks that make up the day-to-day running of the centre. This includes domestic work, gardening, helping with worship, kitchen assistance, maintenance, and much more! Essentially, our Young People's Team keep the wheels turning at our centres.

But they are not merely with us to work. Alongside the work environment, being part of a team of similar dedicated Christians is faith-building in itself. Working alongside mature Christians, regular access to Ellel teaching and mentoring programmes all add up to provide an excellent environment for the YPT to grow in their relationship with God.

Additionally, it is a wonderful way to learn new skills, discover God-given gifts and develop natural abilities. Some YPT continue working with the ministry after their year has finished. Indeed, some of Ellel's senior leaders served as YPT and have stayed with Ellel. This time of growing with the ministry and the rich heritage of being with Ellel is proving invaluable as we move forward into the future.

(We won't mention the large number of young people that have found their life-long love during their time; we have stopped counting how many marriages have come from being part of our YPT!)

The YPT programme currently runs in all the UK centres and Ellel Netherlands. There is no charge to be part of the YPT programme and each person receives a small amount of pocket money each week.



The 'Year of Discipleship and Training' (YDT)

In 2002, Ellel Ministries opened Ellel Gilbulla its first Australian centre. Like several Ellel bases 'Gilbulla' provided the opportunity for young people from around the world to come for a period of time to serve on the 'Young People's Team' (YPTs).

The desire to see these young adults; tomorrow's fathers, mothers, church leaders and key-players in the community and market place, leave Gilbulla after a year better equipped to both know and operate in Kingdom truths, weighed heavily on the heart of our Leadership Team. In 2010, we decided to look at how the YPT format could be modified into creating a formidable 'gap year' experience.

This would move beyond the YPT model of purely serving at a centre with less access to Ellel training, and would split the time of a Young Person equally between service (helping run the centre) and training (receiving teaching, equipping and studying). The decision was also made to offer the Year of Discipleship & Training to just those between 18-25yrs.

It was a daunting assignment but, after much preparation, the inaugural 'Year of Discipleship & Training' was launched in 2012. Eight applicants made up our first intake and the students enjoyed a year of both equipping and service.

The 'Studying and Equipping' half of the program includes participation in our Ellel Modular A School and other selected Ellel Short Courses; times of receiving like-skills input, investment from various guest Ellel speakers, times of personal study and reflection, group challenges, bible studies and morning devotions. The YDT students are also expected to learn and demonstrate effectiveness in basic prayer ministry skills by the end of their year.

Responding to the pastoral needs of the young people, individual 'Heart to Heart' meetings are held with each student on a regular basis, as well as monthly group discussions. Personal prayer ministry can also be arranged if required.

The programme has gone from strength to strength. It has been so amazing to see the way that God has been growing this programme and turning vision into reality! More than that, it has been amazing to see the transformation in some of these young people's lives.

The Future of YDT (Year of Discipleship & Training)

Courtesy of the Executive Leadership giving approval to trial this next development phase - we are pursuing accreditation for our YDT programme to become recognized internationally as a "Certificate IV in Ministry & Theology" in association with Unity College, Canberra. Unity College was deliberately selected, as its focus is not just on theology, educational learning and gaining of skills, but also on personal transformation and character building.

It is hoped that this accreditation process will be successfully completed in 2014, with our 2015 intake being the first to benefit. This involves a huge amount of additional work in establishing assessment procedures etc and we need much prayer and God's favour to successfully complete this.

The YDT program runs annually from January to December. Details of specific course content cannot yet be fully confirmed for the January 2015 intake of the 'Year of Discipleship & Training' (YDT) whilst the accreditation process is underway... YDT

– in a nutshell

The purpose of the 'Year of Discipleship & Training' is to develop young men and women of caliber who can better cope with the pressures, stresses and life's challenges both within and without the church. It is a deliberate attempt to raise and equip whole and mature leaders for the future.

Chelsea (20yr old Canadian):

I went to Ellel Gilbulla in Australia to spend a year in their Year of Discipleship and Training (YDT) program in 2012.

This was one of the most rewarding experiences of my life and I know I would not be the person I am today, or have the relationship with God I enjoy, without the healing I received or the discipleship I gained while I was there.

Through the 'YDT' I was encouraged to look deeper into why I reacted and behaved the way I did,

and to begin allowing God to do the work He wanted to in my life. I discovered there were some ungodly reactions and responses in my life Jesus wanted to work on. In order for Him to do this, there were places in my heart I had to surrender to His Lordship which I had never really done before.

The YDT program aims to bring restoration and discipleship to young adults, and I knew that my growth and relationship with God was a priority to the leadership there.

I also got stretched in areas of leadership responsibility which required me to head-up teams overseeing certain tasks for the smooth running of the Centre. These types of experiences grew my confidence incredibly and increased my management ability greatly! And the prayer ministry skills I learned on the Ellel Modular School (which is part of the YDT) have equipped me to pray and minister to others in ways I would never have been able to do previously.

It was such a rewarding and fulfilling experience that I would recommend the Year of Discipleship and Training (YDT) to anyone looking for a closer relationship with God.

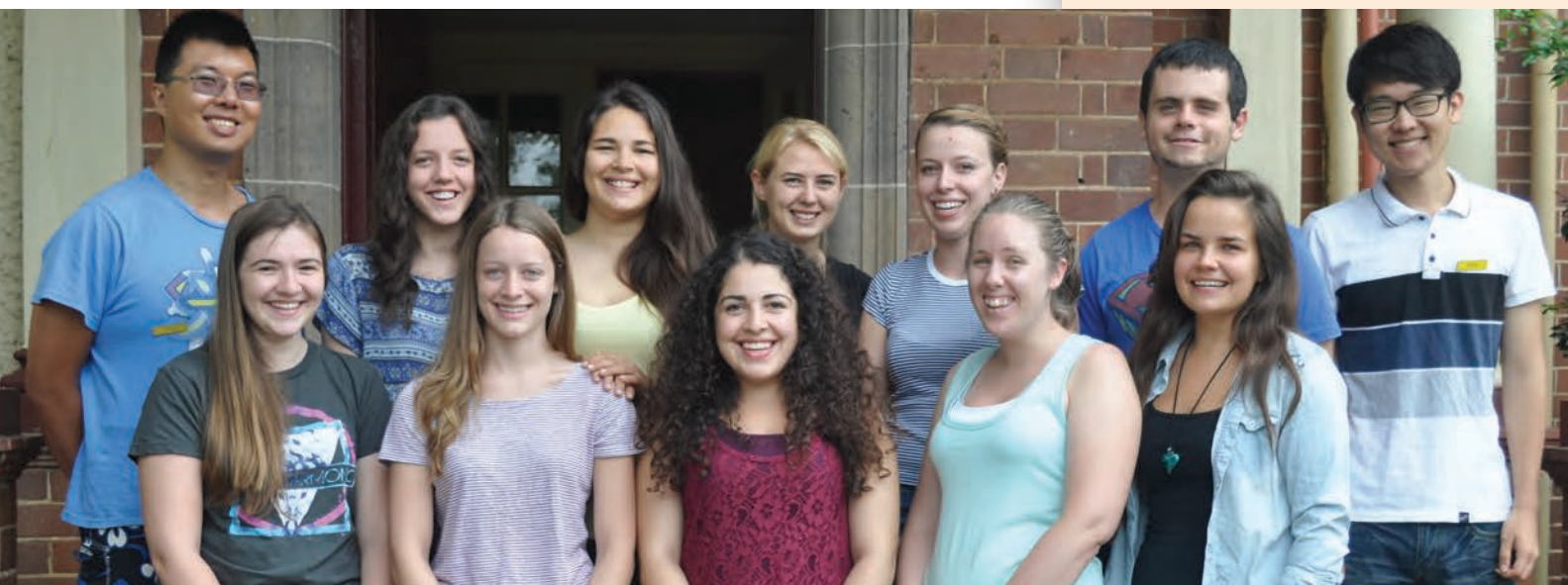
Michael (22yr old German):

The year was not only fun, but full of challenges. What I liked especially was the simple and practical examples of how to apply biblical principals in my day to day life. I was able to find out much more of who God really is and how I could have a personal relationship with Him. Before I came, I lacked the motivation to really pursue God – I just went to Church on Sundays.

However, the YDT year stirred up my excitement for the future and how God will use me for His Kingdom. I also realised how important it is to put some time aside every day to connect with Him.

As my year came to an end, one of my biggest fears was to just fall back into old patterns once I got back home and to go back to being the person I was before. But God showed me that I didn't have to fear. I have been able to stand up for my faith and be confident in it.

Healed from Cancer!

Renáta (Czech Republic) attended an Operation Blairmore retreat at Ellel Scotland.

I was diagnosed with cancer for the second time in my life. This time the doctor told me that it cannot be operated on... I needed a miracle! That is why we started to pray very intensively as a family and also in our church. I received the chemotherapy in pills and I was thankful for this possibility but I totally believed in God's healing.

We did everything we could spiritually together with my husband. We cleansed all that the Lord has showed us according to our measure of understanding and revelation. I took the Scriptures regularly every day because I believe it is God's medicine, the source of His Life and divine health.

After several months my condition was better, we could see a swollen part of my body getting to normal size! It was the result of our everyday confession: The cancer was cursed from its roots; I believed it would continue getting smaller and was going to die and disappear from my body in the name of Jesus.

Then one pastor from abroad recommended that we attend a leaders' retreat at Blairmore House, Ellel Scot-

land. Thanks to the kindness of the people there we could visit the retreat very soon.

We went through several days of pastoral counselling which was led by a gifted couple. Under the leading of the Holy Spirit, we dealt together with the soul ties in my life and generational courses in my family line; I repented from my sins and also on behalf of my relatives. We broke all the stuff in the mighty name of Jesus Christ and applied His life and His resurrection power! The last day they anointed me with oil and prayed for my physical healing.

Several days after our return home I could recognize, that there is no visible sign of cancer in my body!!! This fact was later proven by three careful examinations and by the doctors.

Praise the Lord and thanks to Ellel Ministries. To all wonderful servants - many of them quite young people working in the staff. During our stay we could experience in so many ways, how they practically and faithfully fulfil the vision of Ellel ministry according to Luke 9:11!
